

## WILTSHIRE POLICE

East Grafton Parish Council Police Report



Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2015.

Crimes within this Parish since my last report of 5 November 2014.

### **Wilton. Criminal damage.**

Between 0800 – 1530/07/11/2014 gate and posts removed from the entrance to a field.

### **East Grafton. Theft.**

Between 1245-1500/11/11/2014 handbag removed from an insecure removal vehicle. Incident believed to be connected with similar event in Burbage. Suspect vehicle; white Mitsubishi Evo, with gold wheels.

### **Wilton. Criminal Damage.**

Between 1430/17/11/2014 – 0830/18/11/2014 damage caused to crop of oil seed rape as a result of being driven through.

### **Crimes in other EC11 areas;**

#### **Great Bedwyn. Theft.**

Between 01-15/11/2014 theft of antique staddle stones. Similar other thefts have occurred from the Pewsey area.

#### **Savernake Forest. Attempt theft from vehicle.**

Prior to 0915/17/11/2014 driver's side door lock to a parked and unattended vehicle tampered with.

#### **Wootton Rivers. Non-dwelling burglary.**

Between 1500/15/11/2014 – 1600/18/11/2014 forced entry to shed, nothing believed stolen.

**Wilton. Criminal damage.**

Between 1430/17/11/2014 – 0830/18/11/2014 unknown suspects have driven through fields containing oil seed rape, causing damage.

**Oxenwood. Theft.**

Between 0700-1700/20/11/2014 theft of an Ifor Williams four wheel trailer from a farm.

**Southgrove. Criminal damage.**

2030/22/11/2014 Damage to crops caused by two vehicles driving through fields; black Landrover Defender and a blue Mitsubishi Shogun, occupants believed to be involved in hare coursing.

**Great Bedwyn. Theft from vehicle.**

Between 1445-1455/26/11/2014 driver's window smashed and handbag stolen from beneath seat.

More target hardening measures are being implemented in relation to theft from motor vehicles including sourcing metal warning signage, for fitting at such locations. Please do not leave valuables in your vehicles.

**Great Bedwyn. Suspicious incident.**

Between 2300/27/11/2014 and 0059/28/11/2014 attempt theft of a 4 x 4 motor vehicle, suspects made off following it's alarm activating.

**Burbage. Theft.**

Between 1730/05/12/2014 – 1800/05/12/2014 decorative stones removed from garden.

**Burbage. Theft.**

At 1603/06/12/2014 the driver to a vehicle, part index AJ53, black in colour, obtained fuel and made off without making payment.

**Great Bedwyn. Theft from motor vehicle.**

Between 2200/16/12/2014 – 0600/17/12/2014 theft of pound coins from an insecure vehicle.

**Shalbourne. Dwelling burglary.**

Between 1700/16/12/2014 – 0740/17/12/2014 entry to an unoccupied dwelling. Wood saw and disc cutter stolen.

**Little Bedwyn. Non-dwelling burglary.**

Between 1630/18/12/2014 – 0700/19/12/2014 forced entry to office and stables.  
Nothing stolen.

**Great Bedwyn. Criminal damage.**

Between 2300/20/12/2014 – 0001/21/12/2014, criminal damage caused to the sunroof of a parked and unattended vehicle. A green Apollo Outrage pedal cycle was left at the scene. We are eager to identify the owner of this cycle, to eliminate them from our enquiries.

**Shalbourne. Non-dwelling burglary.**

Between 2130/20/12/2014 – 0001/21/12/2014 forced entry to garage, Husquanna 40/45 chain saw removed.

**Ham. Non-dwelling burglary.**

Between 0000/13/12/2014 – 1900/21/12/2014 forced entry to a barn, Stihl, petrol fuelled hedge cutter removed.

**Wootton Riviers. Martinsell. Theft from motor vehicle.**

Between 0100/28/12/2014 – 1410/28/12/2014 forced entry to an unattended vehicle and handbag stolen.

**Great Bedwyn. Theft.**

Between 1400/29/12/2014 – 1000/30/12/2014 theft of a mobile phone.

**Burbage. Theft.**

Between 1100/06/01/2015 – 0800/07/01/2015 theft of a Husquanna petrol disc cutter from a building site.

**Burbage. Non-dwelling burglary.**

Between 0001/05/01/2015 – 1645/07/01/2015 forced entry to a detached garage. Power tools including a chain saw, petrol hedge trimmer, strimmer and a mountain bike removed.

**Road safety day.**

On Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> November 2014 Pewsey and Marlborough NPT conducted a roads safety day resulting in 83 verbal warnings issued to motorists driving at excess speed, 22 fixed penalty notices issued, 1 vehicle seized and 1 person reported for summons.
